Interim Price Forecast for Turmeric

In 2015, area under turmeric is decreased in Telangana, Andhra Pradesh,

Maharashtra and Karnataka because of moisture stress observed during peak

sowing season of turmeric. In the last two years, three major cyclones, coupled

with unseasonal rains in Andhra Pradesh and surrounding coastal areas lowered

the yield of turmeric. Eventhough the area under Turmeric in Tamil Nadu has

increased upto 20 per cent during 2015 -16, unseasonal rainfall coupled with

prolonged wet weather during the maturity stage of the crop affected the quality

of rhizome. Whenever there is an increase in market prices, turmeric arrivals

are brought to the Erode markets

In Erode godowns, around 1.0 lakh tonnes of turmeric are under storage

with the expectation of better prices. From September onwards the demand for

turmeric may increase because of the onset of the festive season in India

(August-October). So, there may be chances for the price increase for quality

turmeric.

Hence, price forecasting scheme of Centre for Agricultural and Rural

Development Studies (CARDS), Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has

analyzed the last 15 years of turmeric prices prevailed in Erode Regulated

market. According to the results of analysis, farm gate price of good quality

turmeric will hover around Rs. 8000- 8500/Q till September, 2016. Hence,

turmeric producers are advised to take appropriate decision.

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
