Weather forecast for next five days (19.09.2023 to 23.09.2023)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be moderately cloudy. Light rainfall is expected on 19.09.2023 to 23.09.2023. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 32 – 34 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 - 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 - 90 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 - 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 12 – 16 km per hour. The wind direction will be south.

Crop	Stage	Advisory
Rice	Nursery	Prepare nursery for <i>Thaladi</i> rice cultivation by utilizing the expected rain.
		Spread rice straw over nursery bed to avoid scattering of sown seeds due to expected rain.
Cotton	Harvest	Considering expected rainfall, pick the matured cotton boles before rain.
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to rain and wind.
Cattle	Cow and Goat	This situation is favorable for the development of Aflatoxin infection in the Corn kernels and Paddy Straw, which may affect the health of the cattle. To save them from infection, dry the Corn kernels and Paddy Straw before feeding.
