	Flowering to picking	To manage mealy bug in cotton, spray Thiamethoxam 25 WG @ 0.2 g/l or Buprofezin 25 SC @ 2 ml/l.		
Cotton	stage	To manage white fly in cotton, spray Azadirachtin 0.03 (300 ppm) @ 5-10 ml/l or Thiamethoxam 25 WG 0.4 g/l.		
Brinjal	Bearing stage	To manage tobacco cutworm in brinjal, spray Bacillus thuringiensis 2 g/l or Novaluron 10% EC 1 ml/l or flubendamide 0.2 – 0.3 ml/l		
Cattle	Babesiasis	The prevailing weather conditions are favorable for the Babesiasis disease in cattle. High fever, dark coloured urine, less intake of feed and less milk yield are the
