Weather Summary and forecast for Karur district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Karur district, the sky will be clear. No rainfall expected coming five days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 36 - 37 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 - 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 - 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 22 - 26 km per hour. The wind direction will be east.

General		Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to all crops due to light rainfall forecast.

Rice	Nursery	Considering favourable weather, prepare nursery for samba crop and make sowing.
	Main field	By utilizing weather condition land can be prepared for samba rice cultivation before rain.
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.
Cattle	Cow	Since the onset of rainy season may attract mosquitoes breeding, farmers are advised to give Notchi leaves fumigation in dairy barn. Insect population has detrimental effect on milk quality.
