Weather Summary and forecast for Thanjavur district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be moderately cloudy. Light to moderate rainfall expected on 07.08.2024, 08.08.2024, 10.08.2024 and 11.08.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 32 - 34 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 - 28 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 - 60 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10 - 14 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.

Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to rain and wind.				
Sugarcane		To avoid lodging due to heavy rain, detrashing and propping of five month old sugarcane is recommended.				
Cattle	Cow and Goat	Exposure of calves and kids to rain should be avoided to prevent from pneumonia attack in view of expected high rain.
