Weather Summary and forecast for Permbalur district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Permbalur district, the sky will be clear. Light to moderate rainfall expected on 15.05.2024 to 19.05.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 – 38 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 - 28 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 - 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 8 – 14 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.

Crop	Stage	Advisory
General		Raising of green manure crops like daincha, sunnhemp and kolinji can be done to utilizing the rainfall.

		Summer ploughing can be done by utilizing the rainfall expected upcoming days and to control weeds and larva of insects.
		Avoid application of fertilizers and insecticides to the crops.
Rice	Nursery	Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to rice nursery due to light to moderate rainfall forecast.
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to rain and wind.
Cattle	Cow and Goat	Exposure of calves and kids to rain should be avoided to prevent from pneumonia attack in view of expected high rain.

Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to rice nursery due to light to moderate rainfall forecast.
