### Thiruvarur District Past Weather

In Thiruvarur district, during 05.11.2024 to 07.11.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 33 °C - 34 °C the minimum temperature was 26 - 28 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 86 per cent and evening relative humidity was 80 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 4 km per hour and the wind directions were from north east direction.

### Weather Summary for Thiruvarur district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Thiruvarur district, sky will be cloudy. Moderate rainfall expected on 09.11.2024 to 13.11.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 27 - 32 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 20 - 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 90 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 70 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 12 - 16 km per hour and the wind directions will be from north north east direction.

**Agro Advisory**

Crop	Stage	Advisory
<b>General</b>		Postpone/avoid irrigation to all crops depending upon rain condition.
		Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to all crops due to moderate rainfall forecast in the Cauvery delta zone.
<b>Rice</b>	<b>Main Field</b>	One hand weeding is to be given on 20 to 30 days after transplanting.
		If leaf folder symptoms found (folded leaf, white scrape on leaf) avoid excessive nitrogenous fertilizers, remove weeds and Release Trichogramma chilonis @2 cc (40,000/ ac). Spray Phosalone 35 EC 600 ml/ha or Carbosulfan 6% G 16.7 kg/ha or Cartaphydrochloride 50 % SP 1000 g/ha.
<b>Cattle</b>	<b>Cow and Goat</b>	To avoid the occurrence of milk fever in dairy cattle, feeding of supplementary mineral mixture of 15-30g is recommended during pregnancy.
		During night, provide covered shelter to protect animals from cold wind. Feed animal with a mixture of oil cakes and 100 gram of jaggery per cow to maintain the body temperature of animals. Providing mineral mixture @ 30 gram/cow is also beneficial.
