Nagapattinam District Past Weather

In Nagapattinam district, during 22.10.2024 to 24.10.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 33 °C - 34 °C the minimum temperature was 25 - 26 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 90 per cent and evening relative humidity was 77 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 2 - 6 km per hour and the wind directions were from south east direction.

Rice	Nursery	For <i>Thaladi</i> season, medium duration rice varieties like ADT 38, ADT 46, ADT 49, Improved white Ponni, IR 20, ASD 19, Paiyur1, TRY 1, TRY 3, Co 48, Co 49 and Co 50 varieties are suitable.			
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of trees due to rain and wind.			
Cattle	Cow and Goat	Avoid water stagnation in and around the cattle shed. Protect the feed material from direct rain. Animals should not be allowed to drink stagnant rainwater to avoid external parasites infestation.
