Thiruvarur District Past Weather

In Thiruvarur district, during 04.10.2024 to 07.10.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 31 °C - 38 °C the minimum temperature was 25 - 30 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 89 per cent and evening relative humidity was 84 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 4 km per hour and the wind directions were from west south west direction.

Weather Summary for Thiruvarur district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Thiruvarur district, sky will be cloudy. Light to moderate rainfall expected on 09.10.2024 to 13.10.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 30 - 32 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 - 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 70 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10 - 14 km per hour and the wind directions will be from south east direction.

Ge	neral	Farmers are advised to provide adequate drainage facilities to all crops due to light to moderate rainfall forecast in the Cauvery delta zone. Deepen the drainage channel and link with farm ponds towards rain water harvesting.		
Rice	Main field	Considering the light to moderate rainfall farmers are advised to apply fertilizers and herbicides if required.		
Ва	nana	Due to prevailing weather condition five months old banana may be provided with support against lodging and avoid irrigation.		
Cattle	Cow and Goat	Avoid water stagnation in and around the cattle shed. Protect the feed material from direct rain. Animals should not be allowed to drink stagnant rainwater to avoid external parasites infestation. Since the onset of rainy season may attract mosquitoes breeding, farmers are advised to give Notchi leaves fumigation in dairy farm.
