Ariyalur District Past Weather

In Ariyalur district, during 13.09.2024 to 15.09.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 37 °C - 39 °C the minimum temperature was 27 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 64 per cent and evening relative humidity was 45 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 21 - 24 km per hour and the wind directions were from west north west direction.
