Karur District Past Weather

In Karur district, during 13.09.2024 to 15.09.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 37 °C - 39 °C the minimum temperature was 27 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 64 per cent and evening relative humidity was 45 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 21 - 24 km per hour and the wind directions were from west north west direction.

Weather Summary for Karur district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Karur district, sky will be cloudy. Light drizzling expected on 17.09.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 37 - 38 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 - 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 - 70 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 20 - 30 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 18 - 20 km per hour and the wind directions will be from west direction.

Rice	Harvest	Harvest the matured <i>kuruvai</i> paddy.
	Main field	By utilizing weather condition land can be prepared for samba rice cultivation.
Coconut	Bearing Stage	To reduce the button shedding under this weather condition, feed the roots with 200 ml of coconut tonic per palm.
Cattle	Cow	Since the onset of rainy season may attract mosquitoes breeding, farmers are advised to give Notchi leaves fumigation in dairy barn. Insect population has detrimental effect on milk quality.
