Nagapattinam District Past Weather

In Nagapattinam district, during 13.09.2024 to 15.09.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 37 °C - 39 °C the minimum temperature was 27 - 28 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 66 per cent and evening relative humidity was 70 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 6 - 7 km per hour and the wind directions were from south direction.

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Nagapattinam district, sky will be cloudy. Light drizzling expected on 17.09.2024 to 18.09.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 38 - 39 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 27 - 28 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 - 70 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 - 50 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 16 - 22 km per hour and the wind directions will be from south south west direction.
