### **Thanjavur District Past Weather**

In Thanjavur district, during 06.09.2024 to 09.09.2024 the Maximum temperature was recorded 35°C to 39°C the minimum temperature was 27 - 29°C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 75 per cent and evening relative humidity was 70 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 4 km per hour and the wind directions were from West South West direction.

#### Weather Summary for Thanjavur district

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, sky will be cloudy. Light drizzling rainfall is expected on 12.09.2024, 14.09.2024 & 15.09.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 28 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 60 - 70 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 16 - 18 km per hour and the wind directions will be from South West direction.
