Perambalur District Past Weather

In Perambalur district, during 02.05.2025 to 05.05.2025 the Maximum temperature was was recorded 38 - 41 °C the minimum temperature was 23 - 28 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 81 per cent and evening relative humidity was 57 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 8 - 13 km per hour and the wind directions were from north west direction.
