Ariyalur District Past Weather

In Ariyalur district, during 29.08.2025 and 01.09.2025 the Maximum temperature was recorded 36 - 39 °C the minimum temperature was 25 - 27 °C. The morning relative humidity recorded was 70 per cent and evening relative humidity was 51 per cent. The average wind speed recorded was 15 - 19 km per hour and the wind directions were from west direction.

According to district forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department for Ariyalur district, sky will be clear. Light drizzling expected on 03.09.2025 to 06.09.2025. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35 - 36 °C. Minimum temperature is expected to be around 26 - 27 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 70 per cent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 per cent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 14 - 20 km per hour and the wind directions will be from west south west direction.

Rice	Nursery	The Prevalling weather condition favours for thrips infection In rice nursery spray Azadiraction 0.03% (3 ml/litre of water) with sticking agent Khadi Gopura Bar Soap @ 3g/litre 10 days after sowing.			
		Considering favourable weather land preparation can be done for samba rice cultivation.			
Banana	Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.				
Cattle	Cow	Before and after milking, clean the udder using potassic permanganate solution to avoid mastitis disease.
