**Upgraded Children's Park in Tamil Nadu Agricultural University** 

Botanical Garden in Tamil Nadu Agricultural University was established during the year 1908. Total area of this garden is 47.5 acres. Around 800 plant species belonging to 70 genera are being conserved in this park.

Approximately, every year one lakh people including botanists, farmers, research scholars, school children and gardeners visit this garden. This garden serves as a highly preferred recreation place for Coimbatore city dwellers.

A Children's Park is being maintained in this garden. It is one of the oldest Children's Parks in the city and recently it has been upgraded with 18 new play equipments as per the direction of the Dr. K. Ramasamy, Vice Chancellor, TamilNadu Agricultural University.
