

TNAU conducts Agri Business Export Consortium (ABEC) Interface Meet

Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU), Coimbatore has organized the Agri Business Export Consortium (ABEC) Interface meet for agri exporters on 17.11.2022 at Directorate of Agribusiness Development, TNAU, Coimbatore in hybrid mode.
