## TNAU conducts Job Fair 2022 for Diploma Students in Agriculture and Horticulture

Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Centre for Students Welfare, Coimbatore is organizing its first Job Fair for Diploma in Agriculture and Horticulture students of TNAU on 21.11.2022 at Anna Auditorium, TNAU, Coimbatore.

About 248 students from Institutes of Agriculture, Kumulur, Vamban, 36 students from Institute of Horticulture, Pechiparai and 50 passed out students from the three institutes were participated.
