## Centre of Excellence in Biotechnology (COXBIT) and TNAPEx Empower Startups through TNAPEx-RAMP Training Programme

The Centre of Excellence in Biotechnology (COXBIT), Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore, organized a Training Programme on Strategic Action Plan Preparation for MSMEs on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The event held as part of the Tamil Nadu Food Processing and Agri Export Promotion Corporation (TNAPEx) under the RAMP initiative, aimed at enhancing innovation, product development and competitiveness among MSMEs in the State.
