## TNAU grant disbursement function of

## RKVY-RAFTAAR-R-ABI and NIDHI-PRAYAS

Agribusiness Incubation Society (ABIS), DST supported Technology Business Incubator (TBI) functioning in TNAU, Coimbatore is a platform for supporting agripreneurs, farmers, student entrepreneurs and other stake holders from 2011.

The grant disbursement function of RKVY-RAFTAAR-R-ABI and NIDHI-PRAYAS was held at ABIS-TBI, TNAU, Coimbatore on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Prof.Dr.V.Geethalakshmi, Vice-Chancellor, TNAU and President (ABIS) presided over the function and distributed the grant.

A grant amount of Rs.81.60 lakhs from the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, RKVY Division, New Delhi for 10 SAIP Cohort IV Grantees were disbursed as second instalment.

Five start-ups were selected for the GoI-DST supported NIDHI PRAYAS grant of Rs. 10.00 lakhs each. The first installment Grant of Rs.6.0 lakhs (Rupees Six Lakhs only) was disbursed to the selected NIDHI-PRAYASEES.

Dr.R.Thamizh Vendan, Registrar, TNAU and Vice President (ABIS), Dr.E.Somasundaram, Director, ABD, Mr.A.V.Gnansambandam, ED & CEO, ABIS, TBI and ABIS EC members were present.
