TNAU Students Secure International Fellowships

Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) offers B. Tech (Biotechnology) and B. Tech (Bioinformatics) undergraduate (UG) programs. The students with good motivation are able to win international fellowships to pursue their higher studies.

Ms. K. Nivetha, a B. Tech (Bioinformatics) student has secured the prestigious USPC-MIEM scholarship to pursue master's program in Biomedical Engineering in Paris Descartes University, France. In this fellowship, she will get 10000 Euros per academic year. Mr. A. Ragavendran, a B. Tech (Biotechnology) student has secured admission with fellowship in Kyung Hee University, South Korea for pursuing MS in Biotechnology. He will receive a fellowship of 450 USD per month and other expenses will be borne by the Korea university.

Mr. Godwin, a B. Tech (Biotechnology) student has been selected for M. Sc. program in Agriculture and Biotechnology for Sustainable Dryland Development at Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Israel. He will receive monthly scholarship of 2,457 NIS (New Israeli Shekalim), (roughly equivalent to US\$685). The other expenses like cost of accommodation, health insurance and tuition fees will be borne by the Israel School. Apart from that Ms. P. Aberame and Ms. G. Uthra, the students of B. Tech (Biotechnology) and Ms. Vaishnovi Sekar, a student of B. Tech (Bioinformatics) have got placements to pursue masters program in the fields of Molecular genetics, molecular biology and biotechnology, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics, respectively at Lund University, Sweden.
